



Increased Civil and Criminal Liability Expected for Violation of Rail Hazardous Materials Regulations

On February 24, 2016, the Department of Transportation released an audit report finding systemic problems with the Federal Rail Administration's policies, procedures, and enforcement of hazardous materials regulations. The likely effect is an over-correction by the Administration with more inspections, higher civil penalties, and referrals to the DOT for criminal investigation.
